Some of our asks to Bristol and the UK

1. Make sure that Disabled people are part of making all of the city's plans on climate change.
2. Help Disabled people who have to drive to do so in a way that is as good for the planet as possible.
3. Make public transport more accessible.
4. Make parks accessible.
5. Make accessible allotments.
6. Provide accessible resources, information and training to let Disabled people understand and be part of climate change action in the city.
7. Make Bristol's pavements better and less bumpy.
8. Make sure that Disabled people can access the new jobs created around climate change.

Some ideas we plan to do

1. Create a business run by Disabled people that fixes disability aids cheaply.
2. Hire an energy champion to help Disabled people access energy that is cheap and good for the planet.
3. Make a community accessible allotment space where Disabled people can grow food.
4. Run cookery lessons for Disabled people with food that is good for the planet.

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
